North Carolina Department of Public Instruction's Safe and Healthy Schools Support Division requires that first aid kits meeting OSHA standards are properly located, adequately stocked and easily accessible to trained personnel in schools and on school buses.

There are a variety of First Aid Kits available. Ensure your staff and students are best protected by insisting on the following criteria:

Covers All Basic Categories: First aid kits should contain items from the following groups: antiseptics (to kill germs to prevent infection), injury treatment (such as butterfly closures and cold compresses), bandages (a variety to dress and cover a variety of wounds), instruments (tweezers, barrier gloves), and medicines (analgesics at a minimum).


Is Well-Organized: First aid kits are only used in a time of need. If you, a student, or coworker, is injured and need assistance, a first aid kit must be well-organized to ensure the user can find the components needed to treat the injury and can easily assess when items need reordering.

Consists of Only Quality Components: Adhesive bandages are only affective if they stick, maintain their shape, and remain secure in their packaging. The case must be sturdy and open and close easily.

Contains Easy to Read, Reliable First Aid Guide: A first aid kit does no good if you don't know what to do with it. Make sure the first aid guide in your kit is from a credible source, contains the latest medical advice, and that it is laid out in a way that can be understood when under stress.

Ensure your staff and students are fully prepared for emergencies. Evaluate your facility, and keep first aid kits in easily accessible locations in the school building and on buses. Be prepared for minor injuries and real life emergencies.
